VILLAGE OF SOUTH RANGE REGULAR MEETING April 03, 2025 6:00 pm

The Regular Meeting of the Village of South Range Council was held on Thursday, April 03, 2025 at the Village of South Range Community Hall; 45 Trimountain Avenue; South Range, MI 49963

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM. The following council members were present: President Eakin, Trustee Marier, Trustee Hill, Trustee Korby, and Trustee Parolini via zoom. Members absent: Trustee Harkonen. There were 6 guests in attendance. Others Present: Public Works Director Burkman.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Clerk Archambeau read her resignation letter to the committee and put her 2 week notice in that she will no longer be working for the Village of South Range offices.

STREET COMMISSIONER REPORT (Presented by C. Burkman)

Public Works Director Burkman presented the following updates: Local roads are getting negatively affected from the snowy conditions that seem to be coming and going regularly. Potholes will need to be attended to and fixed in spring. Equipment and work trucks were maintenanced and fixed for summer storage.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: (Presented by G. Eakin)

President Eakin attended a Chamber of Commerce meeting in Houghton and did a presentation regarding future plans and developments for the Village of South Range. In attendance with him was Clerk Archambeau and Assistant Clerk Dorsey. President Eakin followed up with interviews from TV6 news and The Daily Mining Gazette. President Eakin addressed the Whealkate Paving grant.

CLERK REPORT: (Presented by S. Dorsey)

Assistant Clerk Dorsey stated that the quarterly taxes are near completed by Clerk Archambeau and that the wholesale water billing from Adams increased by .35 cents per thousand gallons.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

President Eakin inquired if there were any questions or concerns regarding the March 2025 bills, none, and asked for a motion to approve payment of the bills. BUSINESS-UNFINISHED/NEW:

Chief Balma discussed updates and renovations with the fire department. New technology was introduced and discussed. A retirement party will be held for Travis Cline and Danny Hiltinen on April 25, 2025. The fire department tested pagers and will receive funding for new pagers. \$500,000 will be available for an update on the fire truck.

The open Trustee position was voted on. Applicants included Mr. Balma and Mr. Anderson. All ayes for Mike Balma were voted to take the open position as Trustee.
